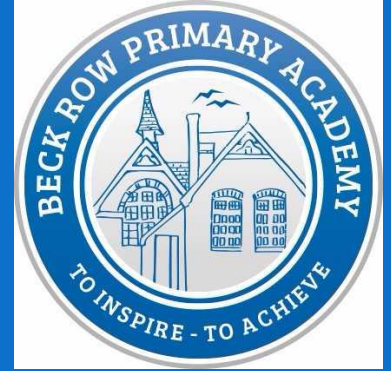

Regular attendance at school is a **legal requirement** and is vital if your children are to benefit fully from their education. Every day your child is absent from school, they miss important lessons. It is very easy for children to fall behind with work but much harder to catch up again when they return.

What is an authorised absence?

- Pupil illness
- **Emergency** medical appointments (Routine appointments should be made outside of school)

What is an unauthorised absence?

- Holidays during term time.
- Shopping trips
- Days off for Birthdays
- Illness of a parent or other family member
- No transport
