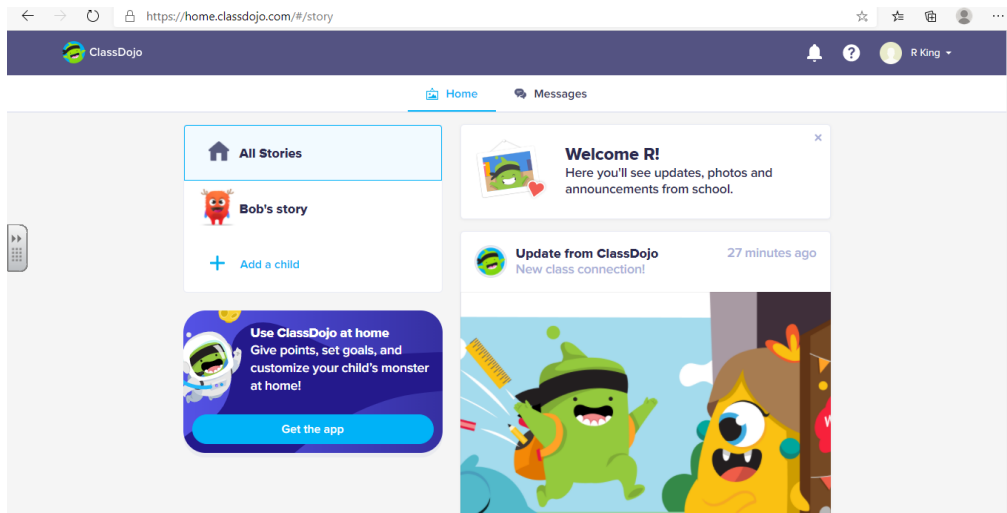
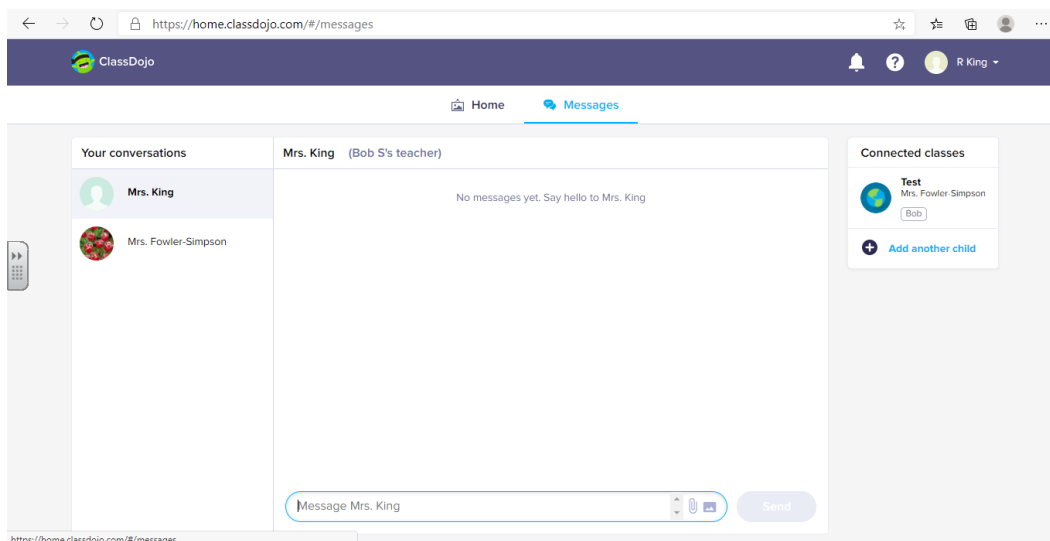


## A parent's guide to using Class Dojo.

Once you have logged into Class Dojo, you should find you have access to your child's story and the class story.

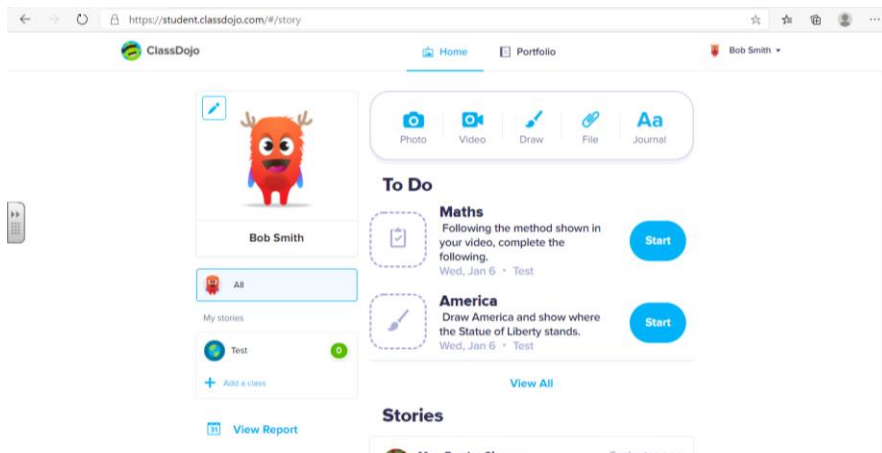


In the class story, your child's teacher will post things which are happening or messages for all children and some of the work for your child, whilst we are using remote learning.

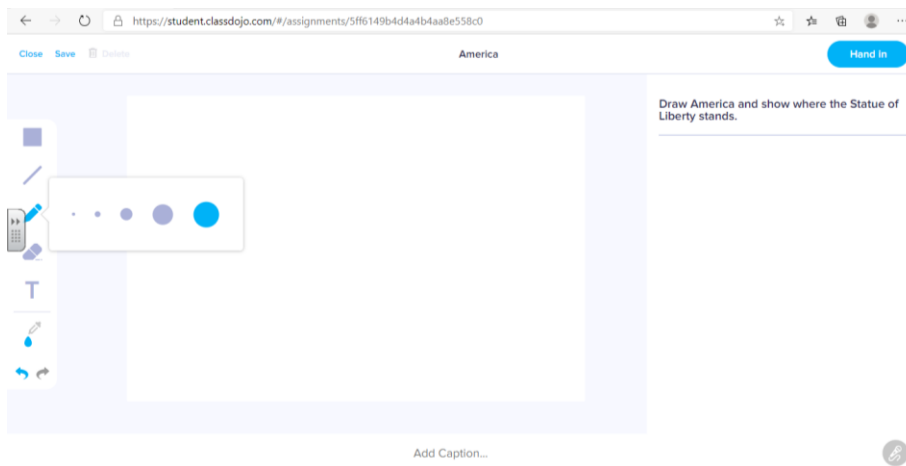


Using the 'messages' tab at the top of the page, you can also message the teacher, attaching work if you wish so that they can feedback on it.

Alternatively, by clicking on the profile image, next to your name, you can swap between accounts, so that your child can access a portfolio, doing their work straight on Dojo, which won't need to be uploaded. Once completed this will then enable you to send it straight back to the teacher for feedback.

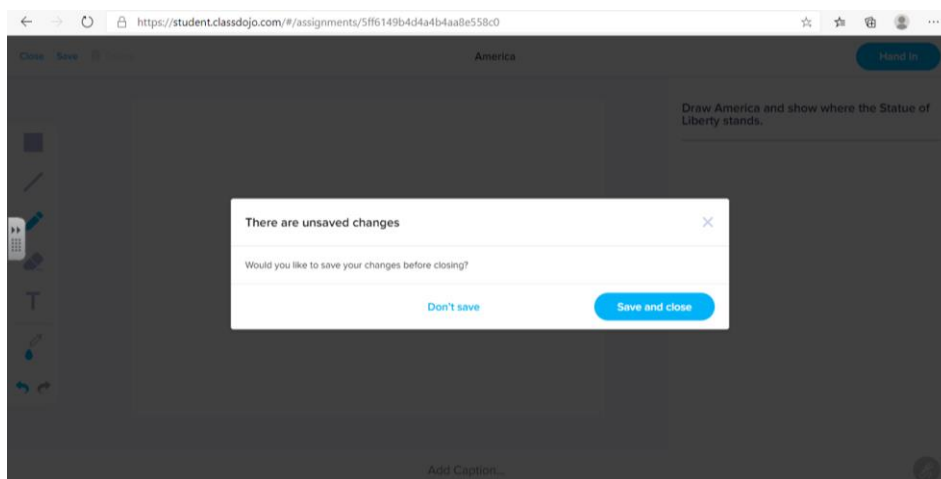


Once in, the work for the week will be in their 'To Do' list, this can be gone to more than once, should they wish to try again.



Inside each activity, the instructions appear on the right, with the tools, for them to use, on the left. Your child can draw and write using the tools provided.

If they need to leave their work before it is complete, they can click on close, which will enable them to save their work and return to it at a later time.



Once complete, click on hand in and your child's teacher will be able to see their work.
