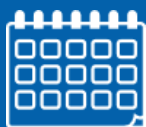

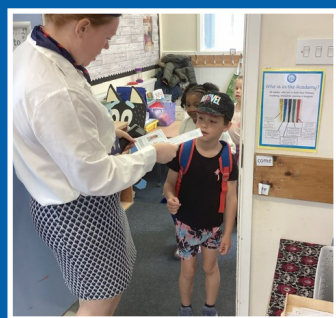
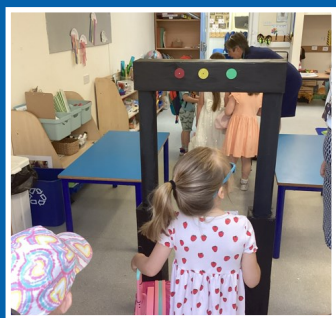
As I look ahead to the summer break, I hope you enjoy a restful and happy holiday. I can't wait to welcome everyone back in September for another exciting year of learning and growth.

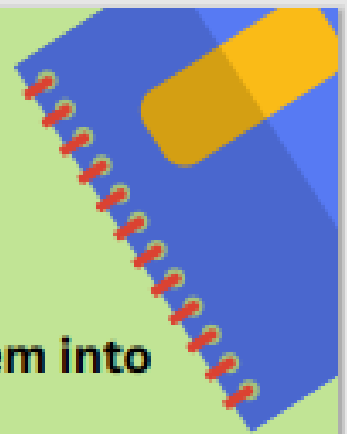

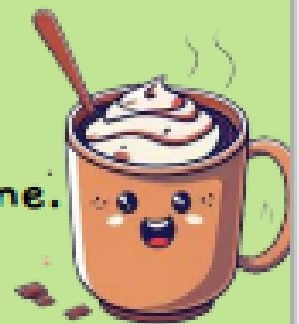

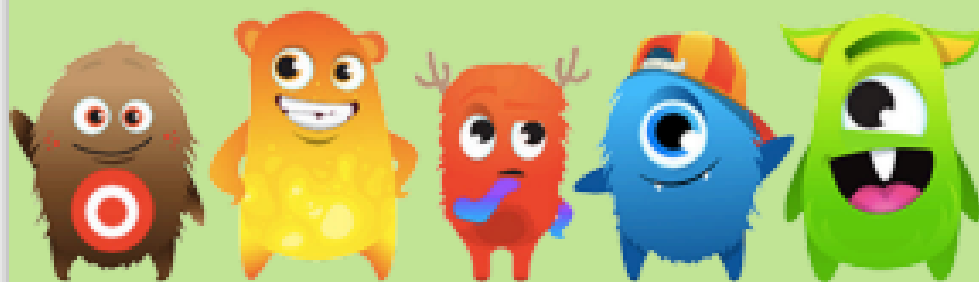

KS1 Dinosaur Day! KS1 had lots of fun with dinosaurs in class! We looked at fossils trapped in amber under the microscope, we handled real life fossils including a prehistoric fish tooth and replica fossils of a T Rex tooth and a Triceratop horn. We then had photos with baby dinosaurs.

Topic Day

In Years 3 and 4, the children took part in an exciting Topic Day centred around our theme, Road Trip USA. Throughout the day, they engaged in a carousel of creative and educational activities designed to deepen their understanding of American culture and landmarks. One station invited the children to plan and sketch a famous U.S. icon—such as the Statue of Liberty, the Disney World Castle, or a Harley-Davidson motorbike. At another, they constructed personal totem poles, incorporating animals and symbols that represented aspects of their own identities. The final activity involved learning about Native American culture through a hands-on paper weaving task. Looking ahead to next week, the children will bring their U.S. icon sketches to life by transforming them into junk models—complete with circuits to make them light up.
